

A study of parents' opinion on online education

This research work was carried out to study of parents' opinion on online education given by GoG in the pandemic era. The questions such as to what extent children are participating in online education, how much interest they have in this learning process and what their parents' opinion is towards this program etc.

Findings of the study

- Connectivity is not a problem during the education program but Internet access required for online education is not always available.
- Teachers do not face audio-visual difficulties during the online learning process. Teachers are not respected, they do not teach enthusiastically. Child does not help with housework.
- Not every parent can afford the equipment needed for online education. Each and every child does not have access to the necessary equipment for online learning at any given time. Online education does not affordable a problem for parents with more than one child. If a child does not have the necessary equipment for online education, that child cannot go to another child and receive group education.
- Children are not interested in online learning process. There is no improvement in the learning process of the child through the online mode. The child does not answer the questions asked during the online learning process.
- If the online learning process has two or more sessions, the child does not participate in each session with equal enthusiasm. The child is not satisfied with this process their Irritability increases. During the online learning process, children cannot get solution of the problem related to their subject. Boys and girls do not participate with equal enthusiasm in this learning process.
- Children may develop eye problems. Excessive use of mobile does not make a child lonely. A child's learning behavior does not become positive. A child becomes addicted to mobile with frequent excessive use of mobile. A few children do revision. During the online learning process, the child cannot present his ideas to the teacher. The instruments required for online learning are not used by children only for the learning process.
- Online learning process is not as effective as face to face learning process.
- The child is not encouraged towards any activity other than the learning process. The online learning process does not deprive the child of the school environment.
- A proper home environment is created for the child during the online education process. In this process parents do not cooperate but Parents do not consider such education process a waste of time. The responsibility to take care of the child does not increase.
