About Children's University:

Children's University, Gandhinagar was established in the year 2009 as a sectorial university with unique concept having 'Child' at a center. The sheer of the concept was honorable Prime Minister Shri Narendrabhai Modi. He conceptualized the idea into reality with the assistance of stalwarts in the field education Shri Kiritbhai Joshi was one of them who contributed in the institutionalizing the concept. About the Award:

For the entire teachers' fraternity Gijubhai Badheka is an ideal for the elementary education with ample experiments. Gijubhai "The Montessori System for Child Education" that marked a turning point in his life. He became completely devoted to child welfare activities and also studied child psychology and experimented with educational methods for teaching children. For the benefit of children, he created and wrote stories, songs, rhymes, riddles and life-sketches of famous people and nature for shaping the children. He became known as the Brahma (creator) of children's literature in Gujarat due to the proliferation of such literature. He established the Balwadi at Dakshinamurti in the year 1920.

- To promote and recognize the contribution in the field of "Early Childhood, Care and Education", there shall be Academic Awards given by the University.
- The university may accept the donations from individuals or organizations to set up academic awards as per the regulation.
- The Gijubhai Badheka Awards for Early Childhood Care and Education (ECCE) is being instituted torecognize the efforts and achievements at the Foundation Stage.

Objectives:

- To promote Early Childhood, Care and Education in accordance to National Education Policy-2020
- To extend the philosophy of Gijubhai Badheka for elementary education and holistic development of the children
- To implement Indian Knowledge System to educate and nurture the children
- To inspire the elementary education system by establishing Shresth Baalvatika

Award Category:

[i] Shresth Balguru:

[A] The person should have at least ten years of experience as teacher/mentor/administrator/counsellor in the field of Foundational Stage of School Education (Early Childhood Care and Education) as per NEP 2020.

[ii] Shresth Balvatika:

[A] Any government/ grant-in- aid/ autonomous/ constituent/ public/ private institution/NGO/ Society/Trust should have at least five years of experience in the field of Foundational Stage of School Education (Early Childhood Care and Education) as per NEP 2020.

The awardees will be felicitated every year on the Foundation Day of Children's University, Gandhinagar (31st July), with a certificate, trophy and a cash prize.

Selection Process:

- [i] Review of the received applications will be done.
- [ii] Selection from the eligible applications by selection committee will be done. Selection Committee members may have telephonic/ online/ offline discussion with applicant/nominees/peers/colleagues/head etc.
- [iii] Finalizing the name of awardee by screening committee and if required the finalists will be informed in advance with requirement further to be Submitted for the final selection of the awardee.
- [iv] The members of committees shall be nominated by the Vice Chancellor.
- [v] The selection or recommendation of committee shall be approved by the Academic Council.

Award Guideline:

- A recipient of the award cannot be considered for the award againin future for the same category.
- Children's University, Gandhinagar reserves the right to consider or reject any submitted nomination without informing the nominee/associated institution.
- Any Indian citizen/institute situated in India can apply.
- Application for the award shall be invited through Children's University website or by sending e-mails directly to the state education department, Centre/State universities and for wide publicity.
- The detailed instructions are available on the website of Children's University, i.e. www.cugujarat.ac.in
- Applicant him/herself can apply directly by filling the application form or external nominator can nominate by filling the nomination form available on the website and submit on or before the due date.
- In case of direct application, nomination is not required.
- Applications are invited in two categories from 1st January, 2023.
- In case of nomination, application must be submitted on or before 20th February, 2023 for further procedure.
- The last date for application is 15th March, 2023
- Every applicant shall submit self-attested proof of their works (documents, tools, report of activities, field visits, photographs, audios or videos and other supporting materials) in scanned PDF copy along with the application form either in Gujarati, Hindi or in English.

- 3. All the supporting documents must be self-attested by the applicant and authenticated by the head of the institute properly.
- 4. Children's University, Gandhinagar reserves the right to consider or reject any submitted nomination/ applications without informing the nominee/associated institution.
- 5. Applicant's details will be treated with respect and it will be confidential.
- 6. If a person is nominated, applications from the nominee will be invited within the prescribed due date.
- 7. The decision of Children's University, Gandhinagar in choosing the awardee will be final and cannot be challenged.
- 8. Any kind of changes/modification may be done by Children's University, Gandhinagar without any declaration if deemed necessary.
- 9. By applying for the award, it is considered that the applicant agrees with all the terms and conditions laid down by Children's University, Gandhinagar.
- 10. Any false information submitted in the application form and violation of terms and conditions will lead to immediate & permanent disqualification of the applicant/nominee for the award.

 - (ii) Shresth Baalvatika 236/-INR *(including 18% GST)
- 13. Fees one paid will not be refunded in any case.
- 14. Payment of fees is mandatory for the acceptance of application form.

- Selection from the eligible applications by selection committee will be done. Selection Committee members may have telephonic/online/offline discussion with applicant/nominees/peers/colleagues/head etc.
- Selection/ Nominated committee may visit the Baalvatika/ Baalguru for verification of provided details if required.
- Finalizing the name of awardee by screening committee and if required the finalists will be informed in advance with requirement further to be submitted for the final selection of the awardee.

Steps for filling forms

- 1. Visit the website www.cugujarat.ac.in
- 2. Download and print the soft copy of the form provided for respective category.
- 3. Fill the form and authenticate as per guidelines.
- 4. Prepare section wise single pdf file of your documents for claim.
- 5. Fill the google form of respective category for which you are applying using given google link and upload your application form and documents section wise in the goodle Link.

a. Document

- Take clear image of any document.
- Make single PDF file of all images as per sequence noted in the application.
- Give file name of your PDF file by section number and name.
- Reduce each file size up to 3MB. (total all files size for uploading in the link should not exceed 25 MB)

b. Video/Audio File

- Prepare video and save your video either in your Google drive or your portal or your channel.
- Copy the link of your video and paste the link in Google form in the proper tab.
- Give access to your video file link to **geet@cugujarat.ac.in**

c. Photographs

- Collect all the photos.
- Make section wise single PDF file of all photographs in sequence.
- Reduce the file size as per requirement.
