i) Evaluation of Dissertation :

Candidates shall submit the dissertation to the M.Phil. Coordinator through their respective supervisors at the end of the academic year, which shall be evaluated by internal examiner (Supervisor) and one external examiner appointed by the University from a panel of four names sent by the M.Phil. Coordinator. The examiners who value the dissertation shall report on the merit of the candidate as “accepted” or “revised and resubmitted” or “rejected”. If one examiner accept the dissertation and the other examiner does not accept, the dissertation may be referred to third examiner and the third evaluation shall be final. The dissertation will be evaluated by the dissertation guide and external referee separately for 100 marks each using Dissertation Assessment Scale along with a qualitative report.

A full-time M.Phil. student shall submit to the university four copies of the dissertation by the end of the academic year/second semester.
