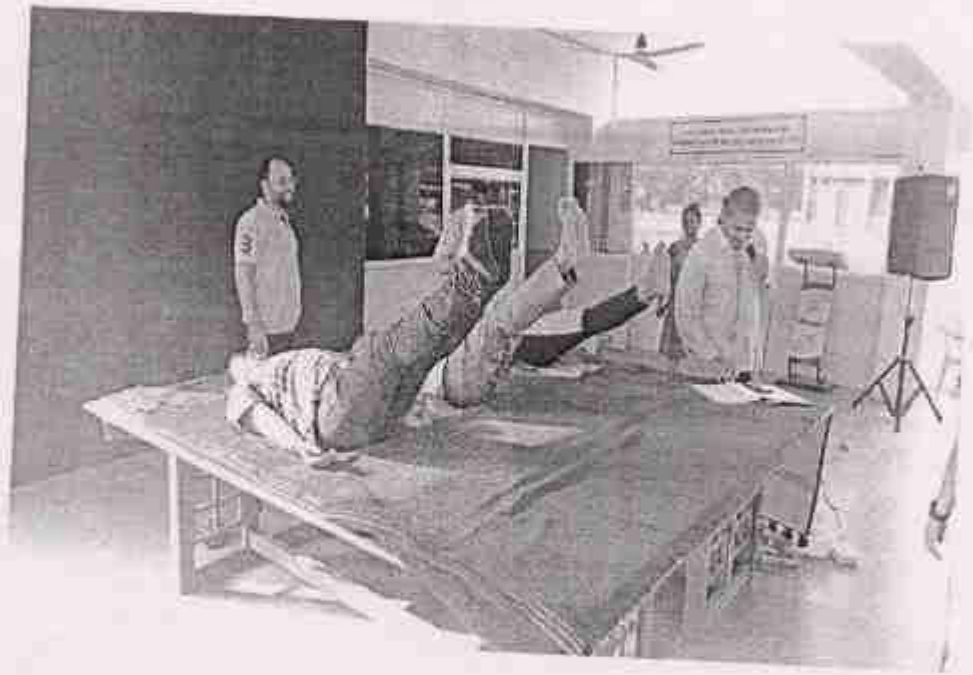


A National Sports Day Celebration at Children's University

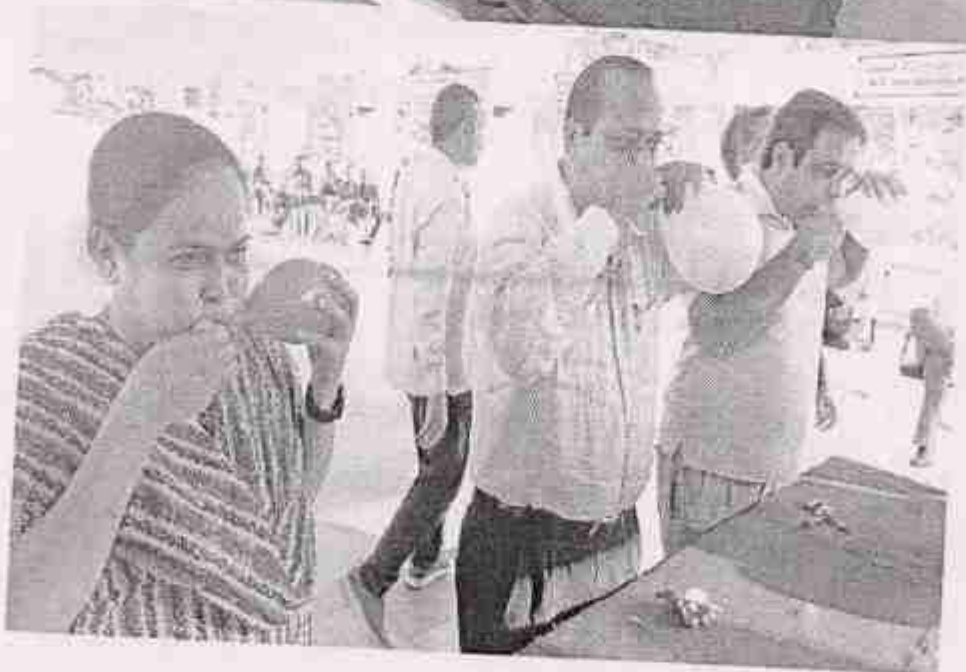
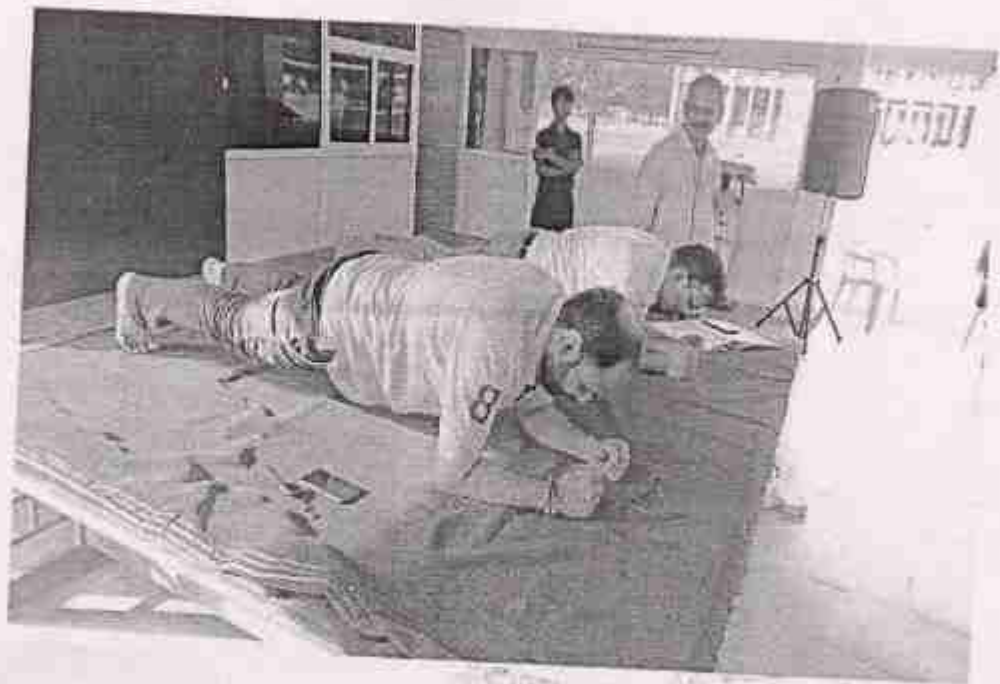

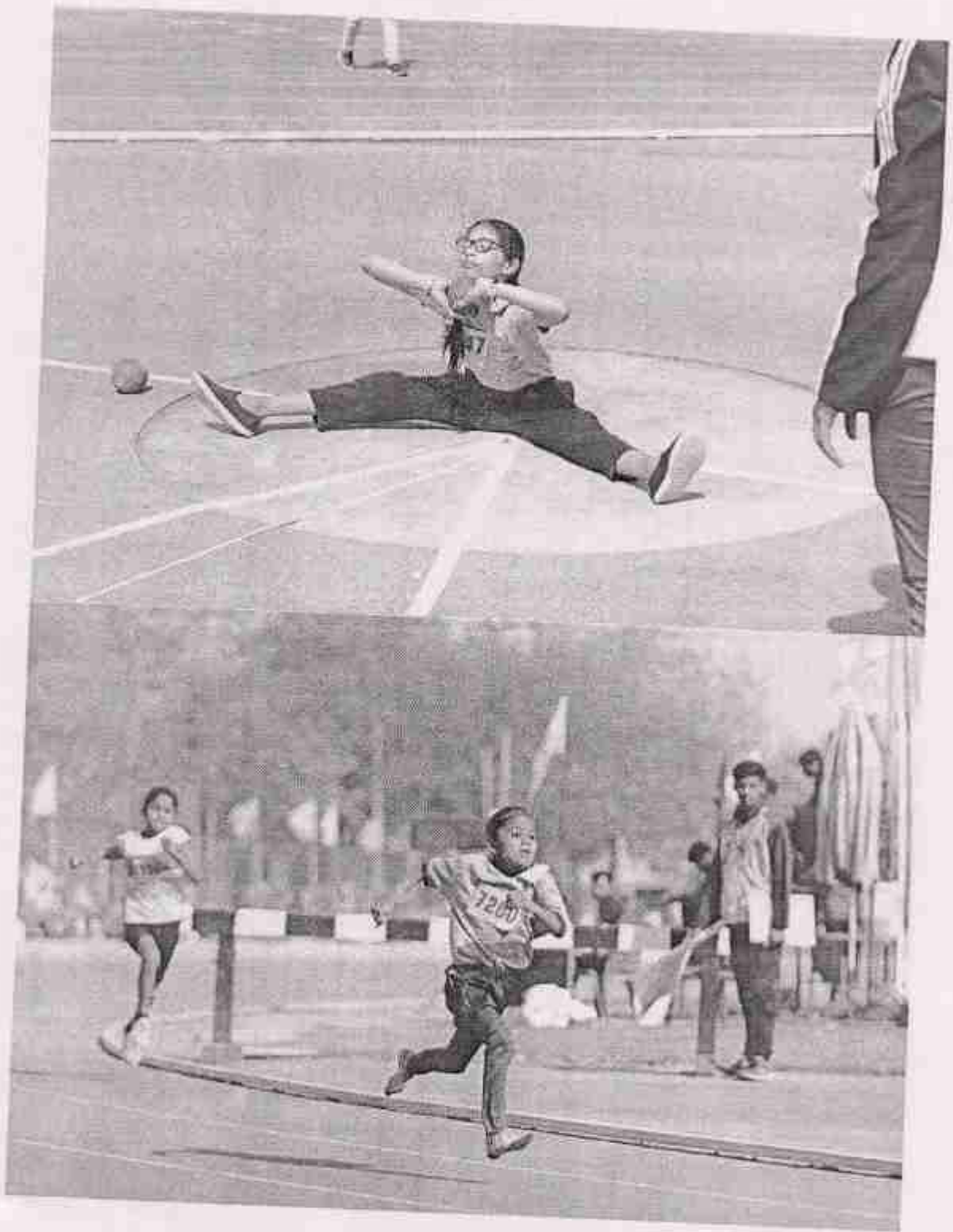
Report on Under 11 Athletics Meet organized by Children's University dated 06/03/2022

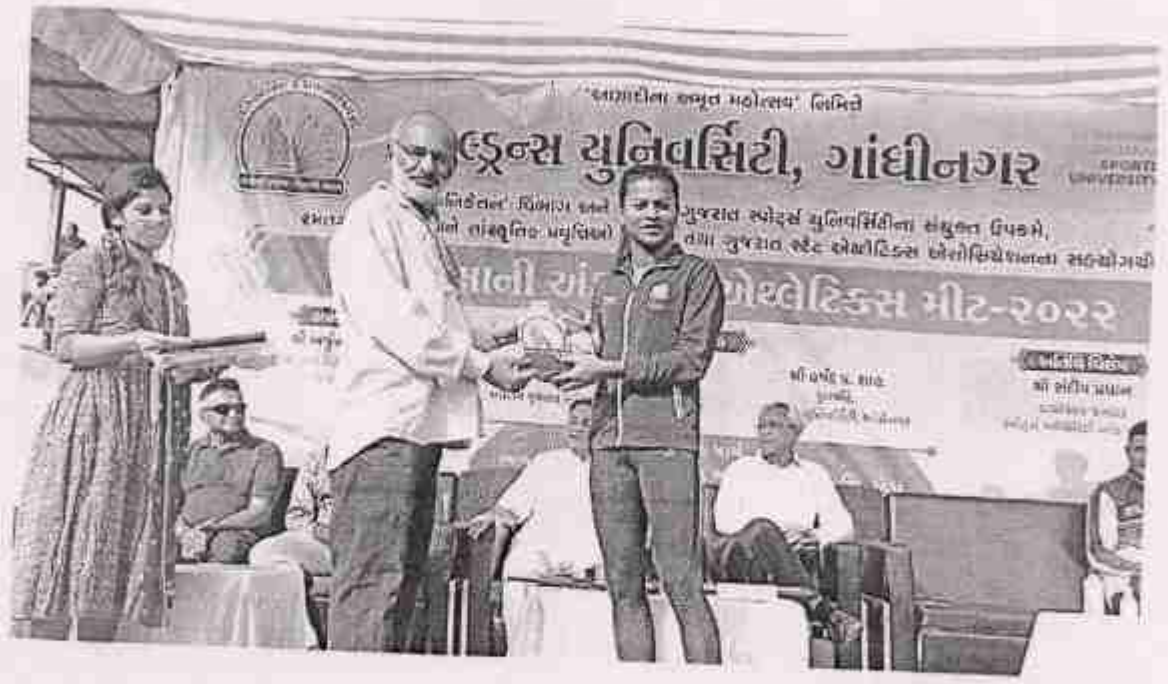
