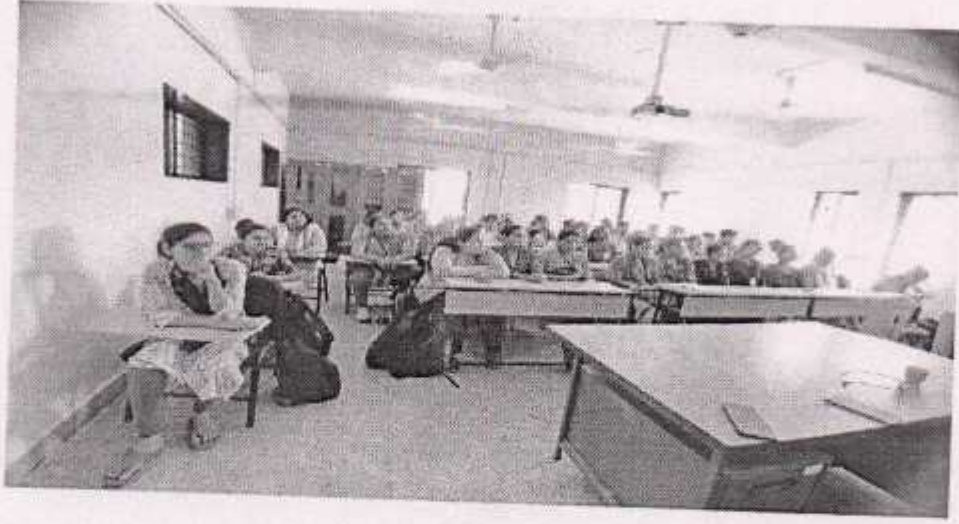
A Report on Teacher Day Celebration dated 05/09/2019
