

Introduction:

The IQAC (Internal Quality Assurance Cell) of Children's University organized a guest lecture on

"Shodhchakra and Plagiarism" to promote research ethics and integrity among the faculty and

students. The guest lecture took place on 6th April 2023, at 11:00 AM in the Conference Hall of

Children's University.

Guest Speaker:

The guest speaker for the event was Mr. Abhishek Kumar, Scientist E at the Information and Library

Network Centre (INFLIBNET), Gandhinagar. Mr. Kumar is an expert in the field of research and has

extensive knowledge and experience in addressing issues related to plagiarism and research ethics.

Guest Lecture on Shodhchakra and Plagiarism:
