Addressing the parents, Mayor of Gandhinagar Shri. Ritabhan Patel said that you are lucky to be able to take advantage of the various centers run by the Children's University located in Gandhinagar. You can develop your children holistically through Shishu Paramarshan Kendra.



After watching the video clip, all the attendees understand that it is very important to teach the parents/families of the society that the various activities can develop their child holistically. Also all the activities done here are at shishu paramarshan Kendra are necessary for the development of the child.

Training Department Asst. Prof.. Dr. Nileshbhai Pandya, following the topic of sensory-emotional development and character formation, said that the mind is dominant in the infant stage. This state is like fertile soil, on which what is sown grows quickly. What and what kind of seeds you want to plant in this land, is in your hands. Explained with examples what should be done to make a child intelligent, develop language, build character. He also told the family how important it is to tell a story every day for the child's emotional and language development.

As the children were present in the program, for their enjoyment, Mr. Hardikbhai Bhatt performed the performance song 'Hon Dhudu Te Dharti Dham Dhamti'. In Abhinaya Geet all children and mothers presented Abhinaya Geet along with Center Coordinator Shri. Divyabehan Rawal.

Shishu Paramarshan Kendra Chief Coordinator Shri Dr. Rupambahen Upadhyay emphasized on the theme of action and experience based learning. She told that one of the main reasons for children's poor handwriting is that a child is held directly by a pencil when he enters school. Before entering school, giving a pencil to a children directly is not a good idea. Before giving pencil to write, children should do some specific activities



related to the development of their hands and fingers which improves the development of their small and muscles. Keeping large such aspects in mind, many activities are done in the Shishu Paramarshan Kendra. Just as one action has to be done on time to mold our body based on time, a child also has to do one action repeatedly with patience for action and experience. She said that parents have to be ideal to make a child ideal.

Children's University hon. Chancellor Shri Harshad Q. Shah Sahib discussed about the medium

of child education which was the most confusing subject for the parents. He said in his speech that the child's mother and family are themselves a school. Education should be in their mother language in which they understand the more. Place stories, nursery rhymes, discussions, etc. in dialogue.
