**Report on ABC**

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With a view to providing academic flexibility, promoting multidisciplinary education among the students through pursuing two programmes simultaneously, the Children's University has initiated effective implementation of Academic Bank of Credits.

**Awareness Programme:** The university organized various activities to aware the university staff and students. A one day workshop to create ABC ID and access digilocker was held. The orientation programme on ABC was carried out in each department of the university. A special tab was prepared for ABC-NAD on university website. A detailed guidelines and Power point presentation on ABC was prepared, shared to the students and the same was uploaded on the Website. The university appointed the nodal officer for the ABC-Digilocker and NAD. The Registrar, Nodal officer, Exam registrar and the IQAC coordinators have attended various workshops and seminars organized by the Higher Education, Government of Gujarat.

**Students' Registration on ABC:** The university has successfully registered on ABC with all the necessary details by the university officials. All the students of Ph.D. and post graduate students have registered on ABC-Digilocker. In all, 218 students have registered on ABC from the university. The students have started using the ABC ID card through the Digilocker application in their smart phone.

**Use and Access of ABC:** Almost all the students are using the Digilocker to track the ABC ID. The marksheets of the students from the academic year 2021 are uploaded on NAD-Digilocker with ABC ID. The students could be able to transfer the deposited credits for pursuing any other programme through their ABC Id.

The ABC web page, team ABC-NAD, awareness materials and marksheets with ABC IDs are the good practices for the implementation of ABC in view of the NEP-2020.
