## About Children's University

Children's University of Gandhinagar, whose developmental goals for children begin with the unborn child and continues till the adolescent stage, is one of the best in the country and the world. The admirable concept of **'Every Child Matters'** was put forward by our Hon'ble Prime Minister Shri Narendra Bhai Modi while he was serving as the Chief Minister of Gujarat. This concept, idea, or mantra led to the creation of this University. As observed by Hon'ble Prime Minister Shri Narendra Bhai Modi "[a] child should be brought up with such warmth and care so that (s)he develops as a healthy human being physically, mentally, intellectually, emotionally, and spiritually." In order to realize this mantra and vision, an institution was established in Gujarat on 31st July, 2009, which is the Children's University.

Currently, the University is dedicated towards teaching, research, training, and expansion in various factors contributing to child-development beginning from Garbhadhan Sanskāra (lit. attaining the wealth of the womb) onwards to birth and to ensure that every child grows up to be the best human being. Moreover, special Departments such as Tapovana (Hermitage), Sishu Parāmarshana (Child Counselling), Bālbhavana (Kindergarten), Accreditation and Quality Enhancement, etc. have been working towards the above-stated goals.

Total seven schools and eleven Departments are functioning in the University with regards to higher education and the University is planning to enrol students in Postgraduate courses for Education, Psychology, Home Science, Social Work, Gujarati, and Sanskrit.

## About Department of Sanskrit

Every country has its own cultural as well as historical background closely related to its language. Sanskrit language is India's cultural heritage. It provides insight into the ideal way life. In contemporary times, the world is witnessing a deep interest in ancient literature. For centuries, scholars around the world have been keenly interested in the study of Sanskrit. The Sanskrit Department is committed to Research in the sixty-four arts and to understand the ideal values and spiritual essence of life.

Through the medium of philosophy presented in Sanskrit Veda, Upanishad, Smriti, Sanhitā, Stotra, Nitisāshtra, the Department aims to spread awareness in the world and society at large about the journey of development from the human to the divine.

The Upanishad is a Sāshtra that rigorously follows the Vedic philosophy and influences several branches of science including that of embryology. Within Garbhohanishad, for example, we find detailed descriptions regarding fetus formation and its development.

The main aim of Sanskrit Department is to impart teaching of Embryology, the teaching and spread of the scientific approach behind the sixteen sanskāra-s, to explain the importance of fertilization to married couples, and to provide guidance to parents regarding the overall development of their child/children along with values education. Nuclear families are on the rise today. The Sanskrit Department aims to revitalize the Indian tradition of familial bonds and relations. Every child develops better under the selfless love and care of grandparents. This Department aims for the holistic development of children through Tapovan Centre, marital education, and familial enlightenment.

## Specialties of Sanskrit Department

- Special study of Sanskrit with regards to Garbhsanskār (the process of educating the mind of an unborn baby) at post-Graduate level.
- The subjects within Sanskrit language which provide valuable and policy-based lessons as well as Garbhsanskār and subjects related to children will be included in the M.Phil and Ph.D. programmes.
- Special Short-term Vacation Workshop for Sanskrit Grammar.
- Every year from June onwards a six-months certificate course will be offered in conversation/ discourse in Sanskrit and language advancement.
- Six-months certificate course will be offered on Smrutisanhitā.
- Six-months certificate course on Peace Management from Shrimad Bhagavad-Gita will be offered.
- Promotion of Sanskrit language through music and modern audio-visual techniques.
- Illustrated short-story books from Sanskrit literature and University publications, songs, etc. will be published in Sanskrit.
- The best and rare works of Sanskrit literature will be compiled and republished.
